We recommend the most appropriate permit for your employee based on salary, length of assignment and spousal considerations.

RULE

- Valid for two years and renewable
- 50% rule: Irish based company must employ at least 50% EEA/Swiss nationals (some exceptions)

Employee presents original work permit and entry visa (if relevant)

Entry visa?

Application Fee



- Nationals of certain countries need an entry visa to travel to Ireland
- Applications made online through INIS and through the employee's nearest embassy
- Up to 8 week processing time (but quicker in practice)

Registration Fee

Registration with Authorities

- Employee must register with the Garda National Immigration Bureau within 90 days of arrival in Ireland
- Employee receives Irish Residence Permit

Renewals

€500–€1500
Government Fee

- Most permits can be renewed for between 2 and 3 years
